

Guidelines for Contributors to IJCC

1. Indian Journal of Criminology and Criminalistics welcome original articles, monographs, research reports and book reviews in the broad field of criminology and forensic Science. The Journal is published twice in a year in the months of January and July every year.
2. All manuscripts and other communications relating to the Journal should be addressed to:

3. The length of the material should not exceed 8000 words inclusive of tables, figures etc. and must be typed on one side of the paper, double-spaced with wide margins on all four sides. Keywords and an abstract (not exceeding 250 words) must accompany the article.
4. Each manuscript should be accompanied by a Declaration that the articles, monographs, research reports and book reviews has not been published elsewhere and not have been submitted for publication in any other journal. The author has also to provide an undertaking stating that plagiarism rate of his/her article is 0%.
5. The hard copy of the typed script (two copies) and soft copy of the same should be sent.
6. For institutional affiliation, minimum identification from the beginning or the complete citation for ex. LNJN National Institute of Criminology and Forensic Science may be supplied.
7. References of the article are made according to the following style:
 - a. For criminology & related disciplines- APA (American Psychological Association) style
 - b. For Forensic Science and other related Science disciplines- Harvard style
 - c. For Law discipline- OSCOLA style
